

**We the undersigned organizations and individuals  
call on the Caithness Corporation, LIPA, and Brookhaven Town to:**

- Stop the Caithness power plant now. The Caithness power plant is a 350 megawatt, natural gas burning, dual-fuel, combined-cycle power plant. This plant will also be home to a 750,000 gallon fuel oil storage tank. The 15 acre power plant site is close to the communities of Yaphank, Bellport, Medford, and Gordon Heights, Patchogue, Hagerman, and Holtsville.
- We are concerned with the lasting health effects of burning fossil fuels 365 days a year near our communities. Our communities carry a disproportionate burden of negative development and environmental harm.
- We believe that LIPA is abusing Bellport's Empire Zone - space reserved for economic development and jobs - for a power plant that will create only 25 long-term jobs. Bellport's Empire Zone should be reserved for developments that create real jobs and industries that add to our character.
- Our air, water, and environment cannot afford anymore attacks. Enough is enough!
